Good afternoon Eli Family,












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 The following are some pictures form the Senior Prom held at Amarantes Sea Cliff. It was a wonderful evening! We will be collecting and sending out more pictures next week.



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









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 The Empower group worked with students in all grades this week on team building and self-leadership.



- Daily attendance is important as it prepares you for professionalism in

 you in the chronic absentee category and may lead to credit denial.
 Communication is important for all absences, notes should be submitted

- As the Eli Whitney students have been extremely cooperative in the
 educational process, we have had numerous situations with student
